As you probably already heard, **ITB 2020 was cancelled** yesterday evening **due to the Corona virus**.

Still, the Roundtable Human Rights in Tourism **would have the possibility to hold a 3-hour event on Thursday, 5 March (from 9.30 am – 12.30 pm) in a different place in central Berlin** and in a smaller group.

The main focus of this meeting would be to **present the results of the conducted on-site assessment** in Myanmar and Thailand 2019 by the Roundtable (as it was planned for the ITB panel), and to discuss possible follow-up measures in Myanmar in a strategic workshop setting.

Please find **attached the final report on the Roundtable HRIA** with the findings, and recommendations for tour operators and the Roundtable, that is ready now. Thank you all for your contributions!

We would like to invite you very much to join this interactive event and discuss the report findings and next steps in an alternative, smaller setting. Our former ITB-panelist Win Min from the Myanmar Centre for Responsible Business decided to come to Berlin anyway and Matthias from focusright is also willing to be in Berlin for this event.

We refer to health authorities that refrain from big events, but state that smaller events in general are not exposed to an increased risk because there are no cases of infection in Berlin at this moment.
